Manual Handling, Electrocution, Transport	 Safe isolations Procedures to be put in place, if isolators cannot be locked of then fuses must be removed and covers to be put in place. Adequate signage to be put in place detailing that the electrical work is being carried out and plant has been isolated. Always use appropriate spanners, try to avoid adjustable as these can slip leading to harm. Ensure test equipment has been proven on calibrated proving unit before testing and after testing to verify that the circuit is dead. Use where necessary mechanical lifting and transport aids especially if removing plant down stairs irrelevant of weight make available use of lifts. Wear PPE safety footwear, overalls and gloves, wear head protection if likely injury from surrounding pipework or obstructions in or around the work area. Transport motor/pump preferably secured to a pallet as soon as at ground level make use of fork lift truck.
