

## Risk Assessment – Goods Lift

## Notes:

- 1. The people that might be harmed: Studioworks employees, contractors, public, artists.
- 2. The goods lift is installed in the Storage Wedge at Television Centre and provides access to the Mezzanine Floor Level.

HAZARD	CONTROL
Failure to maintain / manage the goods lift on a day-to-day basis; resulting in system failure and / or defect.	<ul> <li>This risk assessment should be read in conjunction with the following BBC Studioworks documents:</li> <li>Operation &amp; Maintenance Manual (original instructions) Goods Lift</li> <li>Health &amp; Safety Arrangements for Mezzanine Floor Level</li> <li>All personnel responsible for the day-to-day use of the goods lift to receive instruction and training on the operation, with reference to the above documents.</li> </ul>
Falling at same level or at different levels / Struck by the load or falling objects / Entrapment and/or crushing	<ul> <li>Keep passageways dry, clean and free of objects for the supply and removal of materials on both the ground floor and higher levels.</li> <li>Keep the goods lift access gates and ramps closed when not loading or unloading material.</li> <li>The goods lift is not designed to carry persons. Do not allow persons to remain on the lift while it is moving.</li> <li>Before starting the goods lift, check that there are no persons or objects protruding from the building's structure in the vertical travel of the load.</li> <li>Wear suitable PPE and working clothes with adjustable cuffs. Chains, loose clothes, etc., that can cause entrapment, are not recommended.</li> </ul>
Collapse of goods lift platform and/or structure.	<ul> <li>Do not lift loads heavier than the maximum shown on the goods lift.</li> <li>If a fault is found in the operation of the hoist, lower the load to the ground if possible, unload the material and stop the machine immediately.</li> </ul>

HAZARD	CONTROL
	<ul> <li>Press the emergency stop button in the event of any imminent danger.</li> <li>Spread the weight of the load evenly on the goods lift platform.</li> <li>Do not allow the load to protrude from the sides of the cage.</li> <li>Fix the load when it might move in the cage or exceed its height.</li> <li>If small, heavy loads must be lifted, place them in the centre of the platform as close as possible to the vertical mast.</li> </ul>
Risks of use of goods lift by unauthorised persons.	<ul> <li>At the end of the job, lower the goods lift to the ground.</li> <li>Lock the 'on' switch to prevent use by unauthorised persons.</li> </ul>
