



## Risk Assessment Moving Camera Trolley to and from the Lot Back and Front

The people that might be harmed: Studioworks employees, contractors, public, artists

HAZARD	CONTROL
<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Pushing/pulling heavy load including on a steep hill.</li><li>• Danger of trolley rolling back downhill and running over people behind.</li><li>• Slipping on wet or other poor ground surface losing control of the trolley.</li><li>• Awkward body position when loading cameras onto trolley</li><li>• Trapped fingers whilst loading</li><li>• Knocking into other people or equipment</li></ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Follow manual handling procedures with minimum of two people on any incline.</li><li>• Do not overload and ensure load is balanced.</li><li>• Particular care should be taken with trolley on slopes.</li><li>• Wear suitable footwear.</li><li>• In wet weather minimum of three people on descent of the slope with the trolley.</li><li>• Follow manual handling procedures.</li><li>• Competent staff to undertake procedure.</li><li>• Be aware of surroundings</li></ul>
