Hazard	Control
Risk of Bacterial/ Viral Infection	<ul> <li>All materials used will be handled, applied and removed with all regard to the safety, comfort and hygiene of the relevant parties.</li> <li>All materials will be used for the purpose for which they are</li> </ul>
Allergic Reaction	designed.
Sensitisation	<ul> <li>Hazardous substances will be stored in suitable conditions and with restricted, lockable access.</li> </ul>
Hazardous substances	<ul> <li>Appropriate PPE will be used when necessary.</li> </ul>
	<ul> <li>All substances will have a relevant COSHH risk assessment and are noted on a COSHH register.</li> </ul>
	<ul> <li>Substances should purchased via the approved BBC Studioworks procurement process.</li> </ul>
	<ul> <li>BBC Studioworks will do spot checks on 3<sup>rd</sup> party contractors to ensure they have a sufficient risk assessment process in place.</li> </ul>
	<ul> <li>When a problem occurs with a controlled or agreed substance used by an employee the following preventative measures can be taken:</li> <li>Identify the substances and work procedures responsible;</li> </ul>
	<ul> <li>avoid using the causative agents or procedures;</li> </ul>
