 Injury through manual handling Jib may become unstable or overturn Camera may become detached from its retaining bracket/mount Jib may hit something Finger/hand trap, crush injury Hitting obstructions during Jib movement. Contact resulting in Jib or obstruction becoming unstable. Injury to others from physical contact with moving parts of jib or something falling from the jib 	 Experienced, trained and competent person in control of assembly and operation. The Jib Arm must be placed on a Level mounting. The Jib Arm must be supported at the front during rig/derig. A wire safety bond should be threaded through handle of camera and attached to camera bracket/mount to prevent camera falling any other items that may become detached (lens, viewfinder, etc) should be separately bonded or removed. The operator and others involved in the rigging and use of the crane/jib are experienced in the assembly and operation of this particular apparatus in the required configuration and in similar operating circumstances. Crane/jib should either be placed on a level Track / platform constructed using approved materials and in an appropriate fashion. Make aware to others in the vicinity of the jibs movements or set up an exclusion zone.
