HAZARD	CONTROL
<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Falling or toppling equipment.• Lifting awkward heavy equipment• Awkward body position.• Working in confined space.• Incorrect assembly of equipment leading to collapse.• Slipping down stairs whilst carrying equipment.• Cable being pulled causing camera to topple.	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Police base of stairs whilst rigging.• Divide camera/head into manageable parts to place on mounting.• Follow manual handling procedures.• Follow a safe system of work and make sure emergency arrangements are in place before the work starts. Arrange for co-workers to provide regular checks.• Ensure tripod legs are locked and mounting is secure, bonded if necessary. Likewise if using squatterpod ensure the blocks used to level it are rigid and secure, bond the camera.• Tie cable off to suitable point.
