HAZARD	CONTROL
Pushing/pulling heavy load.	Use competent operators.
Awkward body position.	<ul> <li>Use an extra person to help track, if necessary, for uphill tracks or quick speed changes.</li> </ul>
Slipping on wet or other poor ground surface.	
<ul> <li>Cables becoming snagged or trapped causing dolly to stop suddenly or derail.</li> </ul>	<ul> <li>Follow manual handling procedures.</li> <li>Wear suitable footwear for the conditions.</li> </ul>
<ul> <li>Trip hazard caused by moving cables.</li> </ul>	Ensure free run of cable and use assistants to look after the cable
Pushing dolly off end of track.	if necessary.
Dolly colliding into people or objects.	Ensure people in vicinity are aware of cables and use assistants to look after the cable if necessary.
	Use K clamp on end of track to act as stop.
	Ensure people in vicinity are aware of the dolly movement and ensure no objects intrude into the tracking area.
