



## Risk Assessment Tracking Camera Dolly on Track

The people that might be harmed: Studioworks employees, contractors, public, artists

<b>HAZARD</b>	<b>CONTROL</b>
<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Pushing/pulling heavy load.</li><li>• Awkward body position.</li><li>• Slipping on wet or other poor ground surface.</li><li>• Cables becoming snagged or trapped causing dolly to stop suddenly or derail.</li><li>• Trip hazard caused by moving cables.</li><li>• Pushing dolly off end of track.</li><li>• Dolly colliding into people or objects.</li></ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Use competent operators.</li><li>• Use an extra person to help track, if necessary, for uphill tracks or quick speed changes.</li><li>• Follow manual handling procedures.</li><li>• Wear suitable footwear for the conditions.</li><li>• Ensure free run of cable and use assistants to look after the cable if necessary.</li><li>• Ensure people in vicinity are aware of cables and use assistants to look after the cable if necessary.</li><li>• Use K clamp on end of track to act as stop.</li><li>• Ensure people in vicinity are aware of the dolly movement and ensure no objects intrude into the tracking area.</li></ul>
