Personal Injury Injury to others	 All drivers must be over 18 and hold a valid, full UK driving licence All drivers provided with an induction that covers how to safely operate and charge the buggy All drivers complete a visual inspection before operating the buggy Drivers are to observe extreme caution when reversing and operating the buggy around pedestrians The driver will adhere to the site logistics rules and not exceed 10mph or the site speed limit (whichever is lower) The buggy will only be driven on site and not on the public highway The buggy will not be used to carry members of the public The buggy is regularly inspected and maintained Damage to the buggy must be reported immediately The buggy will not be used in severe weather conditions where wind, rain, snow, ice etc affect the ability to operate it safely During winter months grit will be used across the site Adequate site lighting The buggy has lights to be used in dim lighting conditions
